<p>Petition Summary and Background</p>	<p>Californians, like Americans everywhere, are under stress both financially and psychologically. We had hoped that our leaders would unite us instead of dividing us. However, on May 5, 2020, the California Assembly’s Committee on Public Employment and Retirement pushed forward ACA 5, which would purge a provision from the California Constitution put there by a vote of the People in 1996. Removing that provision (known as Proposition 209) would legalize preferential treatment for some based on race sex, color, ethnicity, or national origin in public employment, public education, and public contracting, which is simply another way of saying that it would authorize discrimination against others. ACA 5 would wage war between different groups and divide Californians at the very time that we need to be united.</p>
